Classroom Mini-Grant Application Form

Purpose: The classroom mini-grant program is an opportunity for industrial technology, technology, or career/technology teachers to acquire funds to support the creation of new and innovative classroom, shop, or lab activities for their students. Funds may also be used to support field trips to sites of emerging technologies such as in producing green energy. A maximum of \$1000 could be provided to a teacher for the support and purchase of materials, tools, supplies, and/or to initiate and complete the activities.

The application must contain the following information:
(2 page maximum)

1. Complete this application form as a cover sheet.
2. Typed description of the proposed activity including:
 - A. description of what the students are expected to learn
 - B. an explanation of why this activity is important
3. Provide a detailed list of materials, tools, supplies and/or travel expenses required, the associated price of each item, and the total amount being requested.
4. The request must also include the name of the class or classes expected to use the activity and the projected number of students who will be involved.
