Future Teachers in Industrial Education FT-1 /FT-2

FT –1. Students will create an instructional display to be used in an Industrial Technology Education, Technology Education, or Career/Technical Education class. The display must include a written explanation including the purpose and student objectives or outcomes. The display can demonstrate how something works or a process in making something, i.e. a prototype, project, mass production activity, etc. which may be taught in a class. Display details are in the rules booklet under FT-1.

FT –2. Students will give a presentation at the State Convention consistent with the FT-2 explanation of the rules booklet. The written explanation may also include a teaching philosophy, program goals, course syllabi, lesson plans, teaching aids, project plans, photographs, hand-outs, worksheets, evaluation, quizzes, etc. Criteria the committee will use in selecting the best instructional displays and/or presentations will include: organization, content, creativity, and anticipated usefulness.

Students who participate in FT-1 and/or FT-2 are also encouraged to apply for a College and University Student Scholarship. Students who plan to participate in the Future Teacher Division should complete and send this application with a brief description to:
